**MARY<sup>3</sup> HIBBEN** (*Thomas<sup>2</sup>, John<sup>1</sup>*) was born January 09, 1797 in Uniontown, Fayette Co., PA, and died after 1860. She married **CHARLES T. BURR** December 14, 1830 in Clinton Co., OH. He was born Abt. 1790 in PA and died 02 September 1868 in Morgan Co., OH.

**MARY HIBBEN 1797 - Aft. 1860**  
**and**  
**CHARLES T. BURR Abt. 1790 - 1868**

Mary Hibben was born in Uniontown, Fayette County, Pennsylvania on January 9, 1797.<sup>1</sup> She was the eighth child of Thomas Hibben and Mary Entriiken. When she was about ten years old, she moved with her family to a farm in nearby German Township. Her sister, Elizabeth (Betsy), and she remained on the farm with their aging parents for twenty years. Then in 1827 they all moved to Wilmington, Clinton County, Ohio.

At the age of thirty-three she married Charles T. Burr on December 14, 1830.<sup>2</sup> The record of one child, Rebecca Burr, born November 12, 1831,<sup>3</sup> was recorded in Thomas Hibben's bible. Another daughter, Sally Mary, was born September 12, 1833,<sup>4</sup> and a son, believed to be Benjamin M. Burr, in 1842. Census records trace Charles and Mary Burr from Washington to Athens counties from 1850 to 1860.<sup>5</sup> Charles died September 2, 1868. His will was probated April 8, 1871 in Morgan county and his heirs were listed as Amelia Parmiter [Parmeter], granddaughter; Charles Parmiter [Parmeter], grandson; and Rebecca Ellis, daughter. Abraham Ellis was the executor and Ephriam Ellis and Mathias Ellis were the witnesses.<sup>6</sup> Charles was a farmer.

Mary Burr is buried in Sugar Grove Cemetery in Wilmington. The records indicate that her remains were moved there after the Cemetery was founded in 1857.<sup>7</sup>
